The McPhillamys Community Consultative Committee (CCC) met again this week, providing an opportunity to update community representatives and Councils on the Project.

Following the receipt of 671 submissions on the McPhillamys Development Application (DA) and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) our team is now preparing a Submissions Report. This Report will respond to issues raised by public authorities. organisations and members of the public.

Regis will also submit an Amendment Report which will outline project finetuning, and changes which have been made in response to issues raised in the submissions received. Both the Submissions Report and the Amendment Report will be lodged with the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) around the middle of the year.

We welcome the comments and suggestions provided by agencies and the community and we will continue to finetune plans as the project proceeds.
