We've had a lot of interest in the project following last week's submission of the State Significant Development Application (SSDA) and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to the NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE).

What happens next?

The DPIE will now review the application and EIS before setting a date for them to go on public exhibition for a minimum of 42 days.

The lodgement of the DA and EIS also marks the beginning of the next phase of stakeholder consultation for the project, including agency and peer reviews, public meetings and hearings, Community Open Days and ongoing meetings with our neighbours, landowners and other stakeholders.

We've also heard from a lot of locals interested in job opportunities at McPhillamys. It will be at least 12-18 months before we have a decision on the application so it's too early to be talking specifics at this stage.
