### Progress towards assessment

The McPhillamys Gold Project is moving towards final assessment, following the recent submission to the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) of further project information.

### Water licensing matters

On 7 October 2022, Regis submitted its response to all outstanding matters raised by DPE Water and NRAR since the McPhillamys Gold Project (MGP) EIS was lodged in 2019.

### Third Amendment Report

On Thursday 20 October Regis submitted a third Amendment Report confirming the water pipeline route and updates to the Schedule of Lands. The second *Amendment Report* (May 2022) included northern and southern water pipeline alignment options.

Further landowner consultation and design refinement has confirmed that the northern alignment is the preferred option.

The third Amendment Report removes the southern alignment from the Project. Updates to the Schedule of Lands in the third *Amendment Report* include:

- Removal of lots associated with the southern water supply pipeline option;
- Updates to lots created by recent property subdivisions; and
- Other administrative changes e.g. addition of details to land descriptions including feature names and maps.

### Consulting landholders

Regis has consulted with landholders and stakeholders impacted by changes and we are continuing to work with them as the assessment progresses. We also briefed the McPhillamys Community Consultative Committee (CCC) about the proposed amendments, at the CCC meeting on 31 October 2022.
