Questions & answers

“When do you start?” That’s the most-asked question we get at McPhillamys, followed closely by, “How do I apply for a job?”

The short answer is that we can’t set a date at this stage as there are still a number of post-approval ‘hoops’ to get through before we start construction.

Approvals process

We are working our way through the supplementary approvals, which are a normal part of the rigorous NSW assessment process.

These include preparing

over 18 environmental management plans and meeting consent conditions which form part of the approval.

Project finetuning

We’re also continuing to finetune and optimize the project, modifying where we can to improve operations and minimize impacts on the environment. One example is a proposed minor alteration to the access road alignment (on Regis-owned land) to avoid established trees.

Investment decision

The final costings and plans will also feed into a Definitive Feasibility Study.

The Regis Board will consider the Definitive Feasibility Study before making the Final Investment Decision for the project.

The Board is expected to make that Final Investment Decision in mid 2024.

Working with us

In the meantime, the McPhillamys local team is growing, with over 20 employees and contractors currently living and working in Blayney and the Central West.

As we move into the next stage of the project we’ll be adding more roles and there will be more opportunities for local service providers.
