Who is eligible?

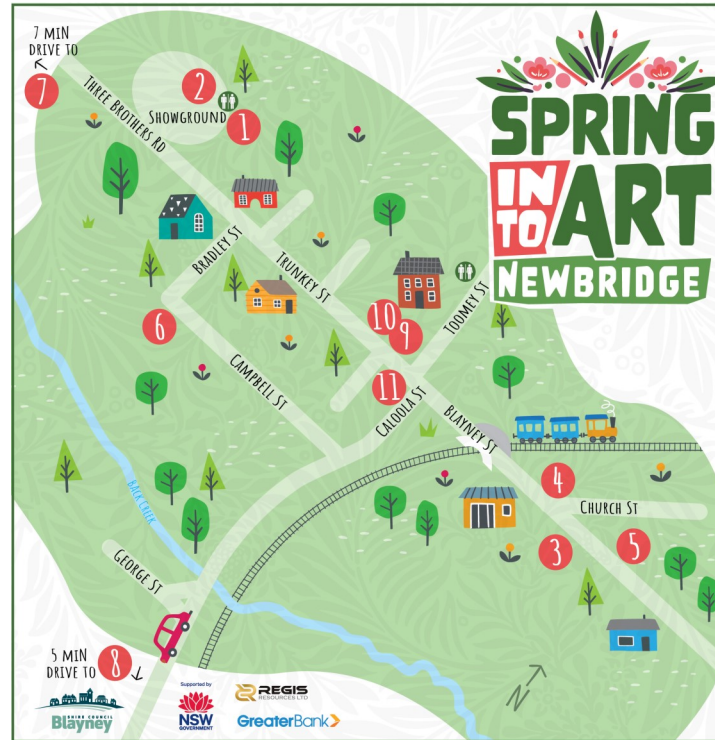
Community Investment grants are open to clubs, community groups, charities in the Blayney LGA, especially not-for-profit and voluntary groups. Focus areas include:
