The DFS is a detailed report covering the technical, economic and environmental aspects of the project. It provides a thorough analysis of all aspects required prior to final Board approval for the project.

Improving native bush

Our team has also been working on plans to improve large tracts of native bush and grasslands at the Aziel property (just south of Blayney) which is owned by Regis.

This included a recent tussock weed spraying program (see photo above right), which was carried out by local contractors towards the end of 2023.
