Did you know your red cells only last 42 days from when they're donated?

That's why regular blood and plasma donors are always needed, because the need for blood never stops.

More blood donations go to people with cancer than anyone else.

Almost 1 in 2 people in Australia will be diagnosed with cancer by the time they turn 85, and more people affected by cancer are reliant on blood donations than ever before.

By 2035 the demand for blood is expected to double.

- 1/3 of donated red blood cells are used for treatment of cancer and blood diseases
- 2/3 of donated platelets go to cancer patients.

- Plasma-based immunotherapy can slow cancer progression.
- During treatment, someone with acute leukaemia can need up to 9 bags of red cells and 36 bags of platelets each month.
