- Consultation commenced, continue over coming months

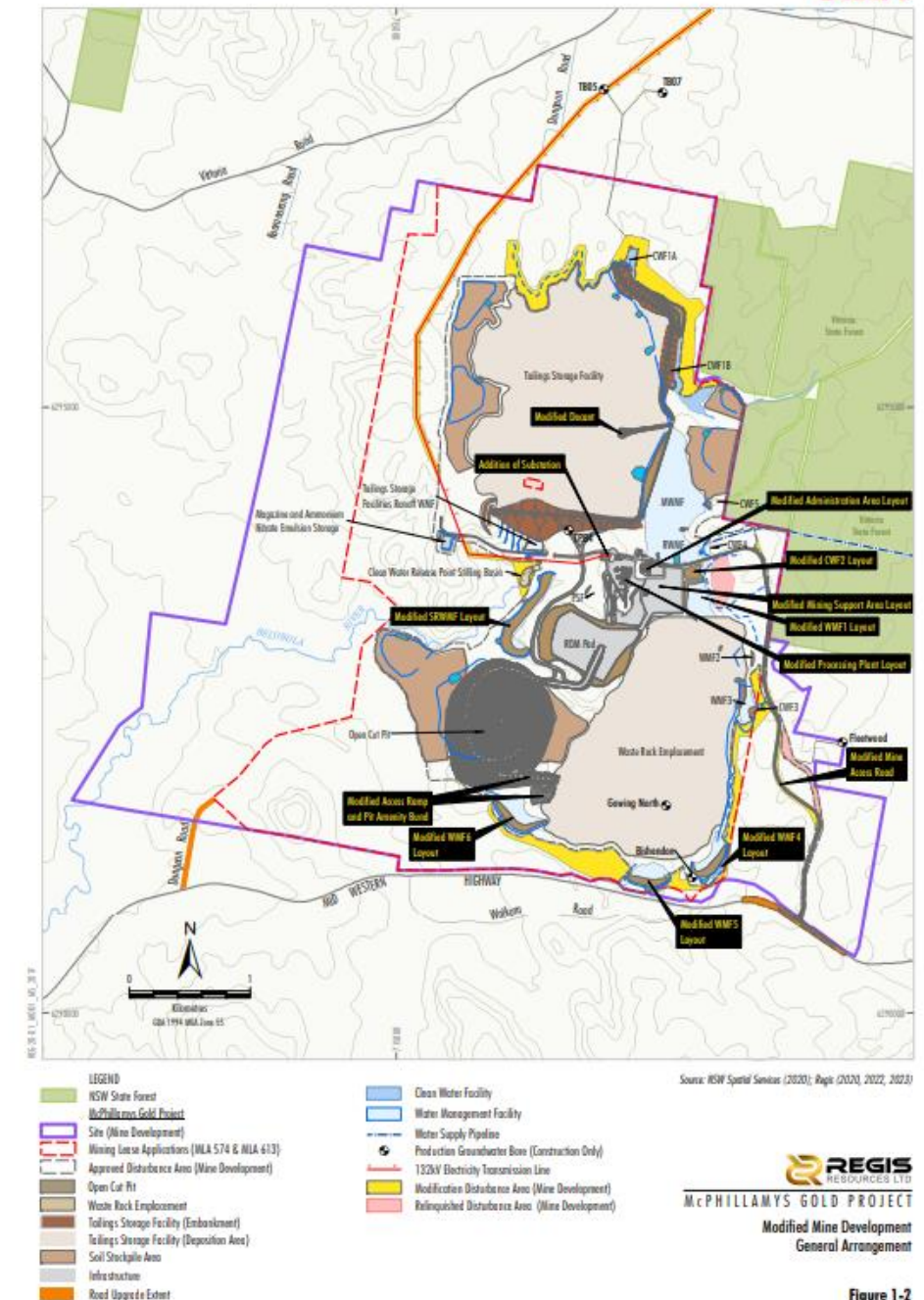

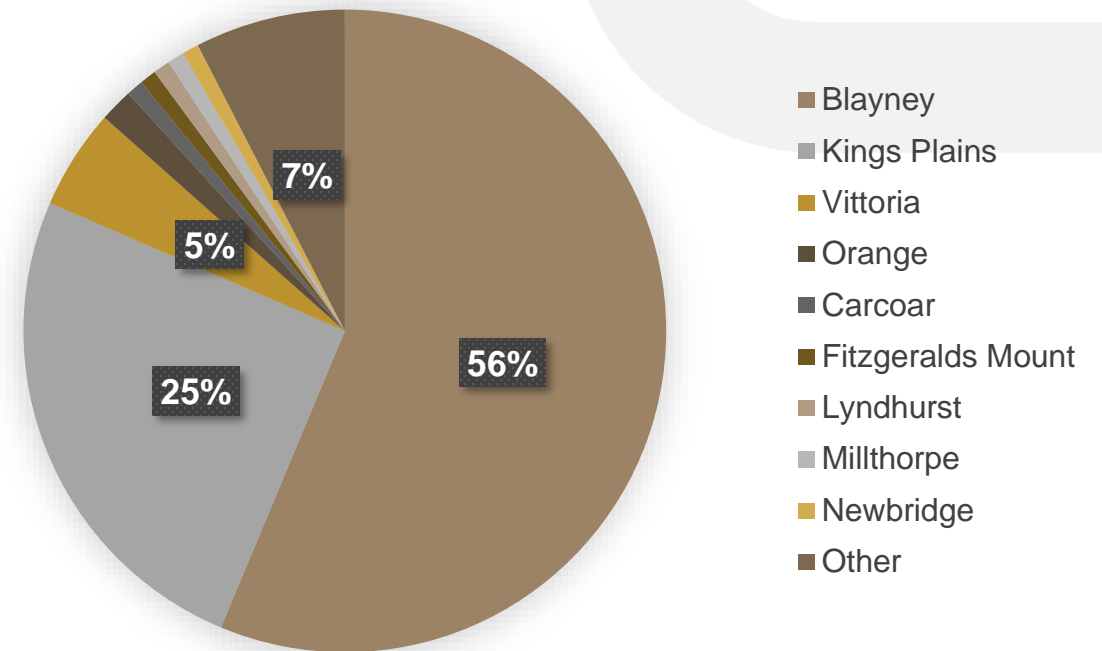
Environmental monitoring

- Continued consultation with EPA & DPHI regarding proposed monitoring network and environmental management plans
- Monitoring equipment – discussions with private landowners continuing, installation planned for coming months
- Ongoing baseline monitoring across the site and surrounds
- Ongoing weed maintenance and pest control activities



Social impact management plan

- Initial consultation rounds complete
 - CCC workshop (9 attendees)
 - Community consultation sessions – 4 (including 41 attendees)
 - Individual meetings (including Kings Plains) – 11
 - Phone calls – 132
 - Emails & SMS – 18
 - Website and other media (e.g. printed newsletters)
