Project update

As many of you will know, early in April Regis announced that the revised capital cost of McPhillamys is around \$1B including pre-production costs. This new development cost reflects design changes and refinements, as well as the widely published global cost escalation experienced in the last few years.

That said, McPhillamys remains a key part of Regis' future growth plans and an attractive gold project with clear upside potential in a rising gold price environment.

Regis' project team continues to work with technical specialists on further refinements that will make the project as efficient as possible. A number of those refinements require a modification to the current approval. The modification application will be made to the Department of Planning, Housing and Infrastructure and we estimate that it will take some months to work through the approval process. The Regis Board will then be in a position to consider a Final

Investment Decision after the modification has been approved.
